

Technology	<p>Weeks 1 – 10 Computer Technology</p> <p>Students will learn to use ICT tools to create new knowledge and products.</p> <p>All students will be using computers and technological devices to support their learning in literacy and numeracy.</p>
Physical Education	<p>Weeks 1 - 6 KiwiSport Hockey</p> <p>Weeks 1 – 10 Throwing, passing and manipulation of small and large balls</p>
Health	<p>Weeks 1 – 4 Emotional Wellbeing</p> <p>Students will learn to identify emotions (at each level of the curriculum) and begin to understand how they help us to stay safe, form relationships and understand our thinking and behaviours. Students will begin to learn about strategies to manage emotions when they feel overwhelmed.</p>
The Arts	<p>Weeks 1 – 5 Visual Art</p> <p>At Levels 1 and 2, students will experiment with paper size, colour and media to create a collage.</p> <p>At Level 3, students will experiment with different collaging techniques eg. paper protruding from surface instead of flat, rolls of paper, 3D-effects etc.</p> <p>Weeks 6 – 10 Performing Arts</p> <p>Students will explore a range of ways of making and performing music.</p>
